Look Closer was created in response to the current exhibition And Yet it Moves by TRES at the Perth Centre for Photography.

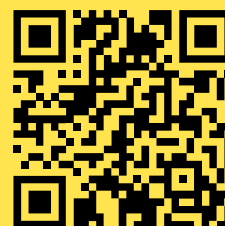
TRES is a Mexican art collective who travelled to Australia in 2016 to conduct fieldwork. The result: 6,383kms, 24 campsites, 29 driving days, 11 flights, and thousands of indistinct, well documented trash and an ecological understanding of its journey.

Instructions

1. Collect your trash kit from a participating business (See locations marked  on the map).
2. Find and collect a discarded object or piece of trash.
3. Photograph it: Place your found object in a well lit area and photograph it. Make sure your camera is on the highest quality setting. Consider the environment around it. Look for a site to use as a background with contrasting colour or textures. Or try photographing in an area with interesting light and shadows. Experiment with different compositions.
4. Submit your photo online (Scan QR code).
Upload your photo by 24 July 2022.
5. Dispose of the trash object into a nominated drop off bin (See locations marked  on the map).
